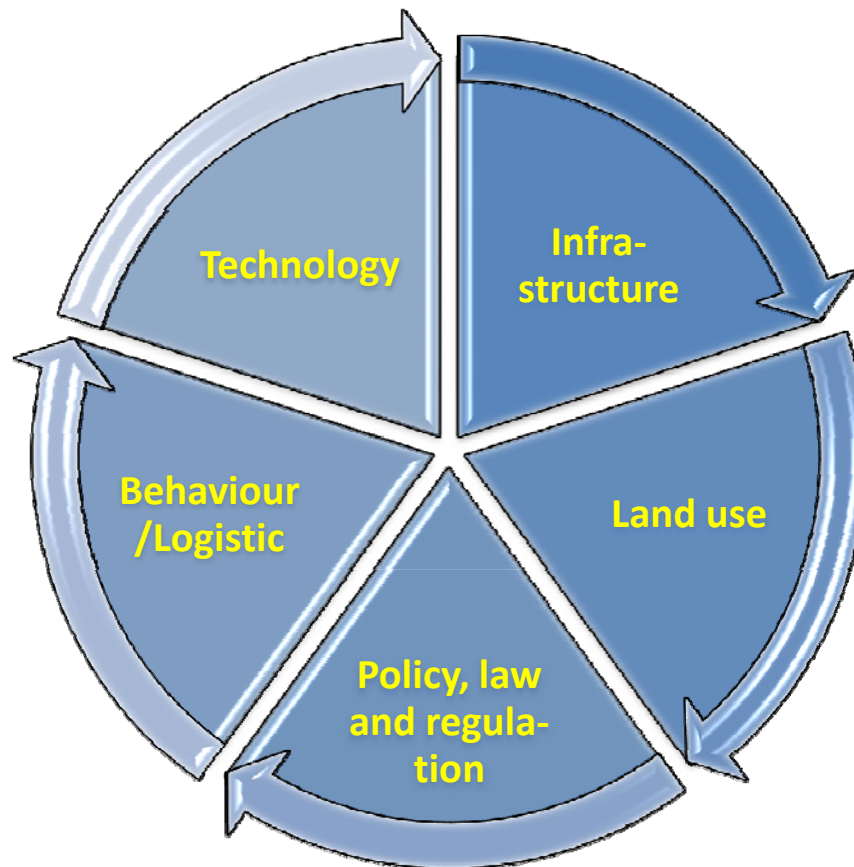


Aim of Ideas Labs

Focal areas to develop the corridors and the operations



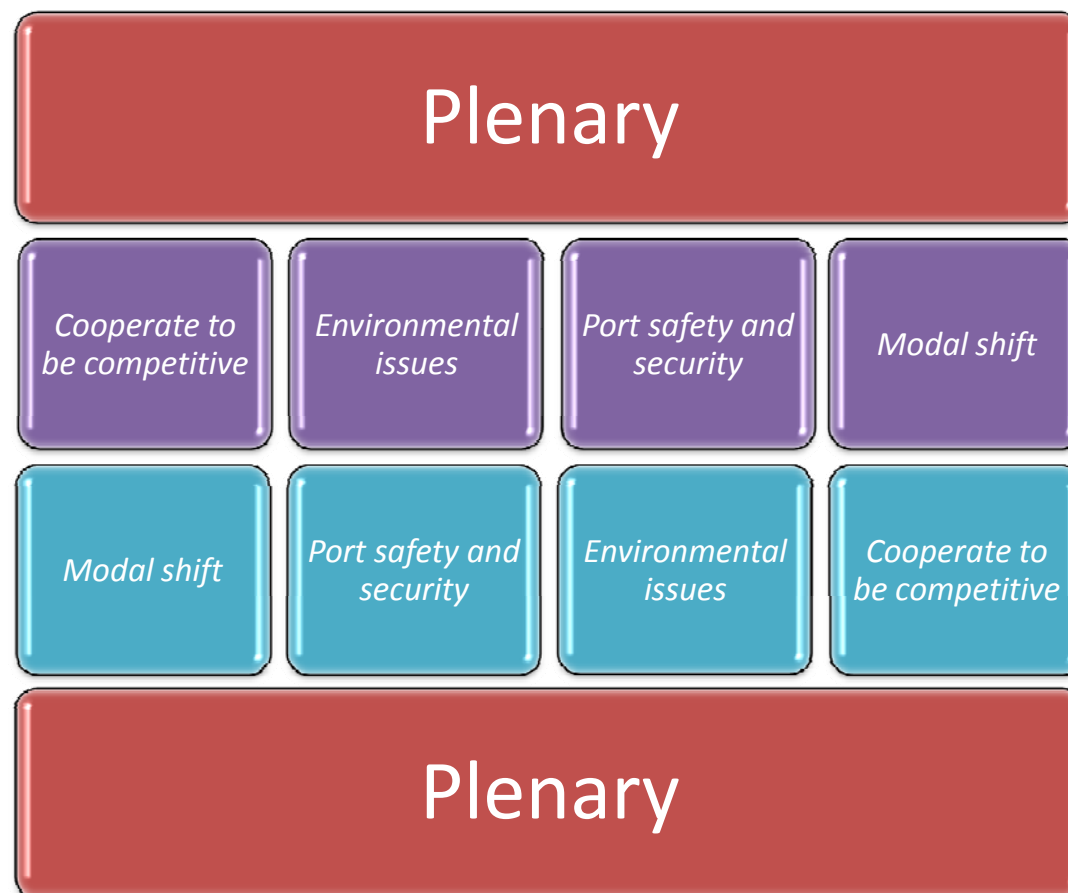
First Ideas Lab: Ports
