# Collaboratively-governed transition to zero-emission

## BSR Access position paper on clean fuel deployment in the Baltic Sea Region

- Strengthening the collaboration between public and private actors
- Hydrogen strategy for BSR (initiative to make Scan-Med and North Sea-Baltic pilot corridors for green hydrogen)
- Coherent infrastructure for clean fuels within the entire BSR

## Coordinative measures to counteract fragmentation

- Corridors should be pilots for coherent roll out of clean fuel applications in transport
- Need for stronger involvement of national actors
- Uptake from EUSBSR Transport PAC after summer break 2021
- Final BSR Access conference in late autumn 2021 on how to continue interlinking strategies with projects transnationally

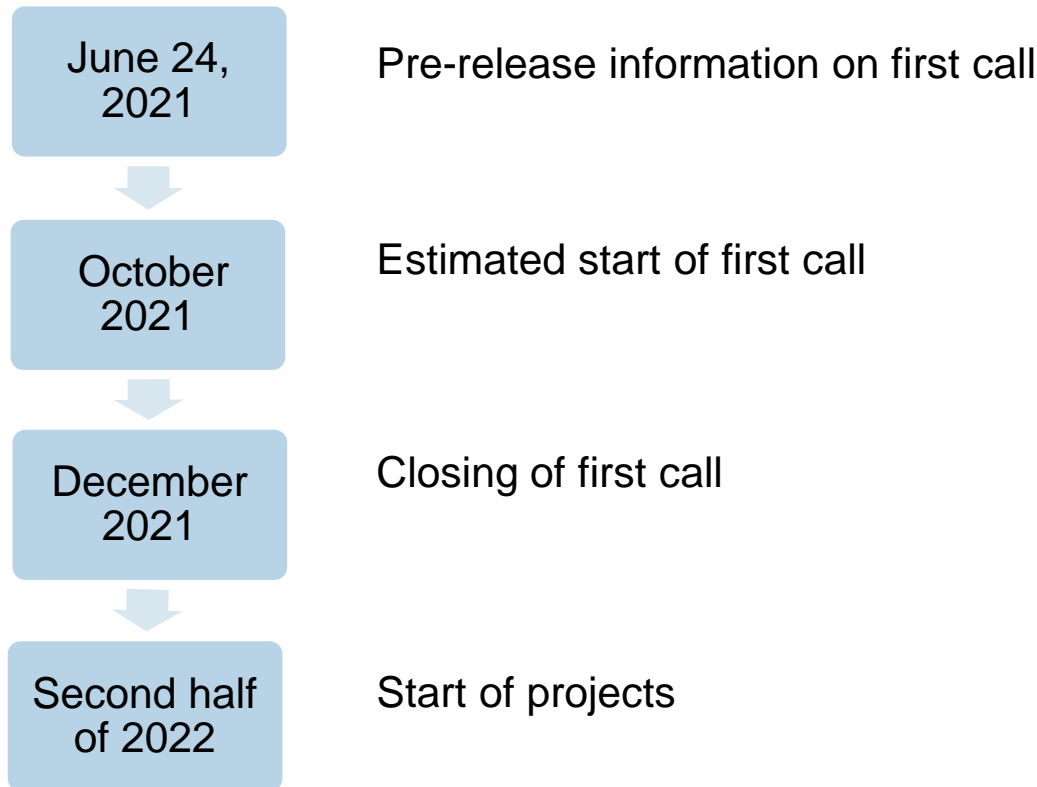
