

# Urgent need of Investments in the Bothnian Corridor and the Gulf of Bothnia Seaports

- Intensified trade relations with Easterns European countries and Asia,
- A third route the Seaports along the Gulf of Bothnia is now completing the two present transport routes via Gothenburg and Malmö.
- The coastal railroad between Stockholm and Luleå (Finland) needs to be strengthened South of Umeå and constructed North of Umeå




# On track to be completed CEF-support can accelerate both planning and construction!

#### **Priority investments (ongoing)**


- Electrification on the border SWE-FIN (with CEF support)
- Port of Luleå expansion and dredging
- North Bothnia Line (with CEF support)
- Double track New East Coast Line (with CEF support)
- Double track Freight line through Bergslagen (with CEF support)

#### **Priority the upcoming years:**

- Completing the North Bothnia Line, the New East Coast Line, and Orebro
- Reaching 250 km/h in line speed Stockholm to Luleå.
- Capacity building improvements, including the Iron Ore line/Ofoten line
