



Price increase from 2021

Development of the:

- consumer price index
- the bridge construction index






Principles of price adjustment for public works in Austria

- Contracts lasting more than one year foresee price adjustments
- Price adjustments are based on specific cost indexes or agreed upon inflation related to project-specific elements
- > So, costs in Austrian contracts include updates due to inflation



Principles of price adjustment for public works in Austria






Principles of price adjustment for public works in Italy

- Contracts foresee fixed prices
- > Estimated costs for contracts in Italy do not include updates due to inflation
- ➤ However, due to the high inflation in 2021 and 2022, the original price lists were not sufficient
- In 2022, a regulation for price adjustment was introduced, which is also applicable to contracts already in force or concluded ("*Decreto Aiuti*"):
 - > price lists foreseen in the contracts have to be periodically updated by up to 20% and immediately applied, even retroactively



Principles of price adjustment for public works in Italy (after 2022)





Effects of price adjustments on the overall costs of the BBT project

Overall costs are updated periodically by summing up:

- Costs of the singular contracts and the management costs (base costs at current prices)
- Costs of the risks, based on a detailed risk analysis
- Costs related to future inflation: inflation forecasts are identified by external experts based on national and international indexes
