Resilience and cross-border study

Study on TEN-T climate adaptation and cross-border investment needs

Objectives of the study:

- ✓ to identify climate risks on the TEN-T network, adaptation measures to address them and their corresponding costs
- ✓ to identify cross-border investment gaps on the TEN-T core and extended core network
 (as defined by the 2021 proposal for a revision of the TEN-T Regulation)
- ✓ inform the Commission's decision-making in determining the investments needed to increase the climate resilience and connectivity of the TEN-T network in the context of the next MFF and CEFIII

Scope:

- ✓ Entire TEN-T for the climate risk assessment, core and extended core network for the cross-border investment gaps
- ✓ Investment needs analysis to focus on 2030 and 2040



Study on TEN-T climate adaptation and cross-border investment needs ctd.

Timeframe:

- ✓ Request for services launched on 23 May 2023
- ✓ Contract expected to be signed in July 2023.
- ✓ First results to be available by March 2024 in time for the TEN-T days in the beginning of April
